Wishing to continue its efforts and to contribute to the development of the history of Rawdon and its various cultural communities, the group undertook in May 2022 a research program on the history of Rawdon and the development of a website available at www.histoirederawdon.ca. The members of the Society meet virtually every month to report on the progress of the work. Since January 11, 2023, it is recognized as a non-profit organization.
